## Admissions Checklist:

- Submit an Application
- Register for ISEE test (5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade applicants)
  - 1) Register at <a href="https://www.erblearn.org/parents/isee-registration">https://www.erblearn.org/parents/isee-registration</a>
  - 2) The Branch School code is 570513
- □ Submit Additional Forms:
  - 1) Recent report card and/or transcript
  - 2) Past school records
  - 3) Teacher Recommendation Forms (Please use the Teacher Recommendation Form(s) for the grade level your child is applying for)
    - <u>PK3 Kindergarten</u>
    - First Grade Fifth Grade

(Note: Fifth Grade applicants need to submit two teacher recommendation forms - one for math and one for language arts)

- Sixth Eighth Grade Math
- Sixth Eighth Grade Language Arts
- 4) Standardized test scores (Stanford, OLSAT, ITBS, ISEE, ERB CTP, CPAA)
- 5) Birth Certificate
- 6) Divorce Decree (if applicable)
